**Course duration**  
 12, 24, 36, 48 weeks of 20, 26 or 30 lessons (15 hours, 19 hours and ½ or 22 hours and ½ per week)

**Class size**  
 18 students maximum/class

 - Homestay including breakfast only or breakfast and dinner  
 - International student residence

- Objectives**
- Improve communication skills
  - Improve vocabulary and core grammar skills
  - Develop knowledge of French culture and civilization
  - Speak and write with fluency and accuracy in every day situation, for professional and/or academic purposes according to the learners' goals and levels in French.

- Course organisation and content**
- Standard courses:** 20 lessons of general French  
**Intensive or Super intensive courses:** 26 or 30 lessons per week with 20 lessons of general French and workshops:
- Level A1: 3 workshops of reading, writing, speaking and listening
  - Level A2: 3 to 5 workshops of reading, writing, speaking and listening
  - Levels B1, B2, C1: 3 to 5 workshops of reading, writing, speaking, or listening and/or culture and/or exam preparation.
- DELF, DALF and DFP exams preparation.
  - Same starting dates for all students, stable learning groups with the same teachers all term long
  - Courses in the afternoon between 1.00 pm and 7.30 pm
  - Homogeneous grouping of students.

- Methodology**
- Communicative and task-based approach
  - Groups of no more than 18 students to give each learner a bigger amount of time to speak and to encourage conversation and interaction
  - Continuous assessment and final exams
  - Extra study outside class
  - Attendance and participation required for fast learning
  - Course certificate based on the number of hours and level in French.

- Spacious and elegant premises in the heart of the student quarter
  - Good nationality mix
  - Individual support: tutoring for students who need help with their courses, or with writing resumes or letters, and administrative support for visa, "carte de séjour", bank account, mobile phone, lodging, OFII, university registration.
